

LEGAL NOTICE

TO ALL PERSONS AND BUSINESSES THAT OFFER OVERNIGHT LODGING ACCOMMODATIONS TO TRANSIENT GUESTS

NOTICE is hereby given that all 19 Municipalities in DOOR COUNTY have joined together in the DOOR COUNTY TOURISM ZONE, and by ordinance enacted a room tax of 5.5% for the promotion of DOOR COUNTY as a single destination for tourism, with an emphasis on overnight stays.

Any person or business that offers lodging facilities or accommodations to the public is required by Municipal Ordinance to obtain a lodging permit, collect and remit the room tax and file the required report on a monthly basis.

Lodging facility is defined as a building or group of buildings in which the public may obtain accommodations for a consideration, including, without limitation, such establishments as inns, motels, tourist houses, or courts, bed and breakfast establishments, lodging houses, rooming houses, summer camps, apartment hotels, resort lodges and cabins, commercial indoor lodging facilities, campgrounds which supply A-frames, cabins or trailers and/or any other building for the purpose of overnight accommodations.

All lodging facilities must obtain a LODGING PERMIT and fulfill the necessary requirements that accompany the permit application or be found in violation of the Municipal ORDINANCE FOR THE COLLECTION OF ROOM TAX ON OVERNIGHT LODGING, at which point enforcement action will commence.
